

Country Water Quality Improvement Program Tungkillo to Mount Pleasant pipeline

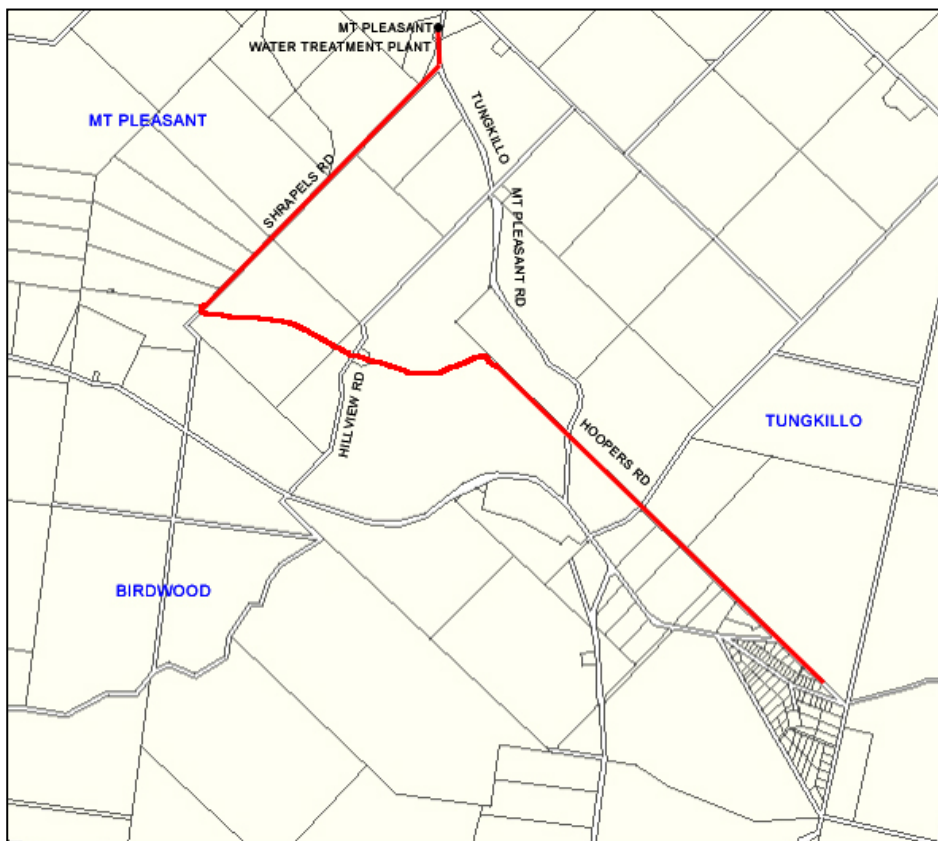
What is the Country Water Quality Improvement Program?

Stage 3 of the South Australian Government's Country Water Quality Improvement Program will deliver high quality filtered drinking water to a number of townships throughout the Murraylands and Riverland regions.

The program began in 1996 with the construction of 10 new water filtration plants. In November 2006, the Government announced the acceleration of Stage 3 of the program, which will see the delivery of filtered River Murray water to 17 communities. This stage includes the construction of 9 water treatment plants and 6 pipelines.

How will filtered water be delivered to Tungkillo?

Tungkillo will receive filtered water via a new pipeline from the Mount Pleasant Water Treatment Plant. The pipeline will be 4.8km long and buried in existing road reserves, verges and easements.

Who will receive filtered water?

Initially, filtered water will be supplied to existing SA Water customers in the Tungkillo township only. However, over time some supply will also be available to properties abutting the pipeline.

When will pipeline construction start and finish?

Construction of the pipeline will start in June 2007 and is expected to be completed in late 2007.

Some activity has already started on site, with tipper trucks and small equipment being used to finalise the design of the new pipe, and prepare for the construction work.

At what times will the works occur?

Works will occur between the following hours:

Monday to Friday 7am – 5pm
Saturday 7am – 3pm
Sunday – no works

What are the likely impacts of the works?

Some noise may be generated during the excavation of the trench. This will include truck movements and reversing alarms.

In digging the trench, there may be the need to break rock in some places. Potential impacts will be monitored as work progresses and measures taken to minimise noise and vibration.

Will there be any traffic restrictions?

As the construction occurs, temporary traffic restrictions will apply to roads along the pipeline route. The main roads affected will include Hoopers Road at Tungkillo and Schrapels Road at Mount Pleasant.

Access arrangements will be made for local traffic.

Will there be any disruptions to the current water supply?

When the pipeline is connected to the current Tungkillo water delivery network and to the Mount Pleasant Water Treatment Plant, some minor interruptions to water supply will occur. Further advice on this will be provided to customers closer to construction completion.
