

ROAD TRAFFIC INFORMATION

The constructor is responsible for organising all road traffic diversions necessary for the construction work to be carried out safely.

The following information has been prepared to ~ in the planning of traffic diversions.

MAJOR TRAFFIC DIVERSION

- i. In the event of a major traffic diversion, an on-site meeting should be arranged with the relevant authorities. The following parties ~ be represented at the meeting -
 - (1) South Australian Police Department
 - (2) Fire Service
 - (3) Ambulance Service
 - (4) Local Council.
 - (5) Trans Adelaide.
 - (6) Department of Transport.
 - (7) SA Water/United Water representatives.
- 3. Once a decision has been made regarding the manner in which traffic will be controlled, a plan is to be prepared showing all the relevant details, ie position of signs and other traffic control devices. A copy of the plan together with a request for approval is to be submitted to the Department of Transport (Traffic Management Area). The request shall include the actual days and dates when the management plan is operating.

A detailed brief of the proposed traffic plan is to be drafted and delivered with a plan of the proposed traffic controls to the local councils and the S.A. Police Department. Details and plans may also be required by the S.A. Fire Brigade and / or Country Fire Services and The St. John's Ambulance Brigade.

Three (3) days notice must be given to the above authorities prior to closing a carriageway except under emergency circumstances.

However it is recommended that these letters be sent between five(5) and seven(7) working days prior to commencement of work.

In the event that regulatory traffic control devices, such as traffic signals, "Stop, Give Way and Speed Limit" signs need to be removed, erected or altered in any manner, Department of Transport approval must first be obtained prior to any action being taken.

Any special signs that are required for a particular job must comply with Australian Standard 1742.3-1996.

For the authorisation of temporary regulatory speed limit signs Refer Code of Practice 'Installation of Road Traffic Control Devices In South Australia'
