

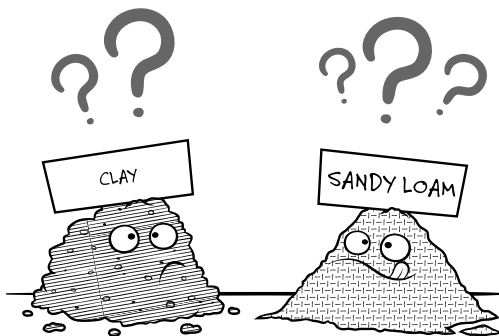

When soil is dry or compacted it won't absorb water quickly. If the water is puddling, stop watering for a while and restart so the water has time to soak.

If your garden has sandy or non-wetting soils, treat it with liquid or granulated soil wetters to help the water get into the soil effectively.

Most soils benefit from added organic materials – dig in manure, compost, worm castings and leaf mould.
