
What does **Kauwi** mean in the Kaurua language?

What artefacts were found on this site?



Look at the wall of SA Water jobs. Choose **one** job you are interested in and write why that job interests you.


What is a water meter, and what does it do?




List **3** things that have been found in our wastewater system.
