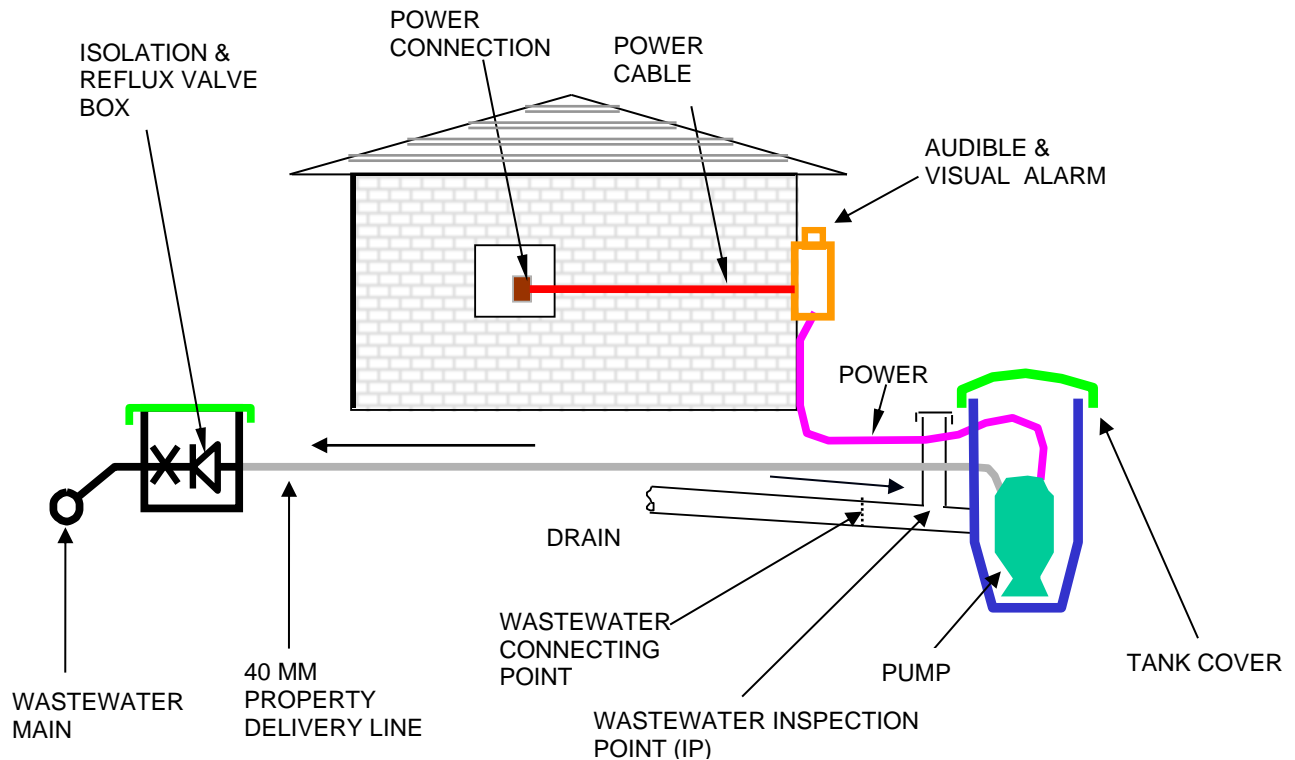


Residential Pressure Wastewater System

A pressurised wastewater system is a lower cost alternative for properties that cannot be serviced by a conventional gravity wastewater main. The pressure wastewater system requires a small underground retention tank and pump to be installed on the property. Wastewater from the house gravitates to the tank and is then pumped into the SA Water wastewater main in the street.

Typical Installation



The pumping units are owned, installed and maintained by **SA Water**.

Payments by Property Owners

Where a property can be connected to a pressurised wastewater system, the owner is required to pay the:

- Payment of all SA Water fee's applicable at the time of application.
- Private wastewater drain from the house to the tank (the work to be completed by a registered plumber), and
- The property owner is required to pay for the ongoing power costs associated with the operation of the pumping unit.

The pumping units are owned, installed and maintained by **SA Water**.
