1 Overview

1.1 SA Water Standards

SA Water demonstrates:

- approved products in a number of Technical Standards (TS 0500 to TS 0507), refer Technical Standards
- 2. and, their **installation** in **Standard Drawings**, refer <u>Standard Drawings</u>.

1.2 Appraisal Basis

SA Water may appraise a product if it considers the item will provide a benefit to SA Water.

SA Water is under no obligation to review any product (even if it has been appraised by WSAA and may be approved by other Water Authorities).

The details sought herein are for the purpose of evaluating the suitability of a product.

An appropriate level of detail shall be provided to enable the assessment to be conducted.

SA Water requires that products to be in contact with drinking water, shall comply with AS/NZS 4020 (2018). Where products have been tested to the 2005 version of this standard, gap testing to clause 6.8 (organics testing) of the 2018 version, must be undertaken and a test report provided to SA Water.

1.3 WSAA Appraisal

A valuable component of the SA Water assessment is a Product Appraisal undertaken by WSAA.

If a WSAA Appraisal has been finalised it shall be submitted together with the Application Form and any requested information.

1.4 No WSAA Appraisal

Where no WSAA Appraisal is available, SA Water will require the manufacturer to submit comprehensive supporting documentation to enable an assessment by SA Water.

Where SA Water has identified a need for a type of product, SA Water may choose to proceed with a product assessment (even in the absence of a WSAA Appraisal).

1.5 Completing the Application

Sections 2, 3 and 6 of the Application shall be completed for <u>all</u> submissions.

Where a WSAA Appraisal is being submitted with the Application, Section 4 shall be completed.

Section **5** is to be completed if a WSAA Appraisal has <u>not</u> been undertaken.

Where a WSAA Appraisal contains certificates and other supporting documents, SA Water will not require copies of this documentation.

For no WSAA Appraisal, certificates, test reports and/ or supporting documents shall be provided.

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Should approval be sought for multiple products, separate Applications should be completed.

By seeking to have a product added to a technical standard, the applicant acknowledges their obligation to provide a sample, or any part of the product when requested to do so by SA Water.

1.6 Size Limitation

For products used within its Reticulation Networks, SA Water has a limitation on the product size.

Please refer to the relevant Technical Standard (TS 0500 to TS 0507) for confirmation of size for the different systems.

For products sized within the scope of TS 0500 to TS 0507 please proceed to complete this Application Form.

Products larger than those within the scope of each Technical Standard are not assessed under this process.
